A native of northern Virginia, Claire Berg attended the Holton-Arms School, where she was a three-sport athlete in soccer, basketball, and lacrosse. During her time at Holton, Claire was named a U.S. Lacrosse All American in 2002, 2003, and 2004. In 2003, she competed on the U.S. Under-19 team that captured gold at the IFWLA World Championship. Claire later played lacrosse at the University of Virginia, where her team captured three ACC championships and appeared in two NCAA Tournament championship games.
